

T-Ball School Rules

Ages 3-4

1. T-Ball School games will be (3) innings or (45) minutes in duration.
2. Once a team has batted through the line-up, then the opposing team will be up to bat.
3. The number of players on the field is minimum 8 and maximum 10.
4. Players are not permitted to “play off” or “steal” a base.
5. The “Infield Fly Rule” is not in effect.
6. A batter may not swing until ball is place on tee.
7. A batter has three (3) chances to hit the ball into fair territory. If he/she does not succeed he/she is declared out.
8. Once a player has the ball in his/her possession in the INFIELD, he/she may call “time”. At this point all the base runners must stay at the base they are on. If in the coach/volunteer’s judgment, a player is halfway down the base line, he/she may advance to the next base. A play may be made on the runner if he/she tries to advance.
9. A batter is declared out if he/she slings the bat.
10. The volunteers can keep score during the game; however, no official scores or standings will be kept in the T-Ball School League, at this age the main focus is to teach the players the fundamentals and to have fun.
